

- The Maha Bodhi Society of India is the premier International Buddhist Organisation founded by Bodhisattva Anagarika Dharmapala in 1891. Foundation stone was laid down by the Councillor General of Japan in 1936.
- Buddha Vihar was built with generous donation of Shri Raja Baldeo Das Birla Ji.
- Buddha Vihar was inaugurated by Mahatma Gandhi on 18th March, 1939.
